Please note the **official language** of Austria is **German**. The authority will do its best to communicate in English but for legally binding declarations you will have to use the German language.

D. Closing statement

- 1. I can only apply for **one** residence permit. It is not possible to check several residence permits or purposes of residence on the first page.
- 2. I have entered all the information correctly. I have not intentionally misrepresented anything. I am aware that all relevant documents must be presented in person at the time of application. I have provided all the relevant documents I have. If the authority requests translations, I have to provide them in German.

If a document is not in German or English, it is recommended to have my documents translated before applying. Then the authority can work faster.

3. I have to provide my address. The authority sends all letters to this address. If this address changes, I have to report this to the authority immediately. For example when I move. If the authority is repeatedly unable to deliver a letter to me, it will discontinue my application. Then I will not get a residence permit!

I can also specify an authorized recipient. The authority then sends my letters to this person. What an authorized recipient is can be found on page 2 under *authorized representative*.

If any of the information on this form changes, I must report this to the authority immediately! I have to do this in writing. I also have to send all relevant documents.

4. **I have to collect the residence permit personally!** If I have a legal representative, I have to collect the residence permit personally and my representative must also be present. For example, the mother or father can be legal

representatives for their child. People with disabilities can also have a legal representative. Children under the age of 14 do not have to come along to collect the residence permit.

- 5. If I have a residence permit according to No. (2), (4), (5), (6), (8), (9) or (10) on page 1 I have to comply with module 1 of the **integration agreement**. That means I have to learn German.
- 6. If I provide wrong information or if I don't provide all relevant information, it's possible that I will not get a residence permit! It is also possible that the authority will not extend my residence permit. This can also happen if I do not follow points 1 to 5 of this closing statement.
- 7. If I receive a residence permit for a certain employer for the first time, I am only allowed to work for that employer AFTER collecting the residence permit. The employer's name is written on the back of my residence permit. If I lose the job, quit, or want to change the employer, I have to report this to the authority and the AMS (Austrian Labor Market Service) immediately! This applies, for example, to the Red-White-Red Card, the EU Blue Card or au pairs.
- 8. If my **family circumstances change**, I have to report this to the authority! For example, if I get divorced. I have to report this no later than one month after the change in circumstances.
- 9. I am not allowed to marry anyone just to get a residence permit! I am not allowed to enter into a registered partnership with anyone just to get a residence permit! I am not allowed to arrange a marriage or registered partnership for anyone just so that they can get a residence permit.

I am not allowed to adopt anyone just to get a residence permit. No one can adopt me just to get a residence permit. I am not allowed to arrange an adoption just so that someone gets a residence permit.

These marriages, registered partnerships and adoptions are punishable by law! That means I will be charged. I may have to pay a fine or go to jail.

It is also punishable if I give false information in order to get a residence permit!

- 10. If I commit an administrative offense, I have to pay a fine of at least 50 Euros and up to 250 Euros.
 - I have to immediately inform the authority if the purpose of my stay changes. I am only allowed to do what is related to the purpose of my stay.
 - I have to hand in residence permits that are no longer valid to the authority.
 - I have to immediately report to the authority if someone has stolen my residence permit, if I have lost it or if the residence permit has become damaged. I also have to report immediately if my data changes. For example, if I get married and have a different name.
 - If my family circumstances change, I have to report this to the authority after one month at the latest. For example, if I get married or get divorced.

I am committing an administrative offense if I do not comply with the statements in point 10.

E. What do I do if I want to extend my residence permit?

Before your residence permit expires, you can **personally** apply for a new residence permit. You can apply for another residence permit

- no earlier than three months before expiry of the current residence permit and
- no later than the day on which the residence permit expires.

The expiration date is on your residence permit. Please make an appointment in due time.

If you submit the application too late, the application is considered an initial application. This means you will probably have to leave Austria. In this case you would have to submit the application while abroad. This is stated in Section 24 of the Settlement and Residence Act. The abbreviation for this is NAG. By signing I confirm that I understand the instructions above. This is the instruction according to Section 19 paragraph 7 NAG.
